Angela,

We do not need a reminder about anything that occurred during the June meeting. We were present and are fully aware of what was discussed.

As I explained to you and the residents before, if patrol officers are not going to stop at night and knock on residents' doors, they are not going to do so during the day either. The officers are paid to patrol the area. If they spend a significant amount of their shift stopping to talk with residents, then they are not actively patrolling. People also have a tendency to engage officers in lengthy conversations, which takes away from their patrol time.

The officers do issue tickets in the neighborhood. I am not sure how you expect them to issue tickets while also stopping to have conversations with residents. Please explain how that would work. If they are spending their time talking to people, they cannot simultaneously be patrolling and addressing traffic violations.

Once again, we only have an officer in the area for 25 hours per week, while there are 168 hours in a week. We cannot expect the officer to work beyond the hours for which they are paid. They are doing an excellent job with the time and resources available to them. The way this is being presented makes it sound as though they are not doing anything, which is simply not the case.

I will send you the updated information regarding patrol.

Regarding the signage, we do not currently have funds allocated for signage. I also need to understand why you contacted someone to obtain pricing for CPID-related signage without first discussing it with us. You stepped beyond the committee's direction by taking that action yourself, and that is not appropriate. This was not discussed or approved at the June meeting. We will not be getting them. Then you only sent it to Sheila.

As for the No Solicitation and No Truck Route signs, I do not believe those are CPID signs. We are not going to purchase items simply because you would like to have them. You buy them under the HOA and no we are not going half with you.

Regarding the most recent crime incident, there was never an "all clear" issued. The individual was not located, so I do not understand how it could have been considered an all-clear situation.

I also do not recall the last signage request being discussed during the meeting. We will see what we can do regarding the sign coming into the neighborhood.

You also listed a request for stronger action regarding speeding. If you believe stronger enforcement is necessary, you need to contact the city or the appropriate court regarding that issue. The officers only have the authority and responsibility to issue tickets when violations occur. If the person is not warranted they will not arrest them.

Finally, I do not understand why you need anything from across Baton Rouge regarding the LPRS. This is something you are pursuing independently, and we are not going to participate in something like that. Go to the real crime unit and get it yourself.

We need to make sure that everyone stays within the responsibilities and decisions of the committee and that actions are discussed and approved before anyone moves forward on behalf of the board.
