From CPID June meeting

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Glad we had improved resident attendance at the June CPID meeting. Just a reminder on the items below from the June meeting.

Resident requests sent to CPID Board prior to June meeting

- Have patrol members acknowledge and meet residents as part of their patrol activity so that they know neighbors vs persons passing through the neighborhood.
- Have patrol directly resolve EBR inoperable vehicle/junk car violations in the neighborhood.
- Address speeding in the neighborhood and issue tickets to violators
- Address stop sign violators and issue tickets
- Provide neighborhood alerts on crime risks or occurrences
- Continue to provide life-threatening crime or shelter in place alerts
 - Add communication updates to know when "all-clear" or continue "shelter-in-place"
- Provide stats on neighborhood and neighborhood perimeter crime stats.
- Provide stats on our specific patrol results including call responses, tickets written, and any crime interventions.
- Provide signage for Patrol on Duty, No Solicitations & No Truck Routes at all Southern Heights entrances.
- Maintain the Southern Heights entry sign.

Requests discussed by residents in June CPID meeting

- Request that the CPID process junk cars for removal from the neighborhood including junk/inoperable vehicles stored in backyards
- Request that the CPID provide calls statistics from dispatch records to know the calls reported on parking, loud noise, etc at the house on Nottingham and Harding. NOTE: calls may be reported by physical location (Nottingham & Harding) vs the address of 7953 Nottingham.
- Request for stronger action taken on drivers who are speeding. Report needed on the number of speeding traffic stops and tickets.
- Request for stronger action taken on drivers running stop signs. Report needed on the number of speeding traffic stops and tickets.
- Information requested on the number of hits from the Southern Heights LPRs that impacted crime resolution in Southern Heights and across Baton Rouge
- Requested more patrol interactions with neighbors.

Requests assigned to residents/SHPOA during CPID meeting (responses below)

- Contact school board on school bus speeding
 - When speeding occurs (buses are directed to drive 5 mph below the speed limit) - Report speeding by calling 225-361-3912 (George) and provide the following information:
 - School bus number (visible at the sides, back and front of bus)
 - Date & Time speeding was witnessed
 - Street where speeding was witnessed
 - EBR School Safety Group will investigate. NOTE: They can track bus route activity and speed
- Determine when Southern Heights is scheduled for LED street light installation throughout neighborhood
 - District 2 is awaiting response from Entergy on our scheduled LED street light installation

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
